**What you can do:** Wetlands can become contaminated or overdisturbed through land-use changes. It takes up to 500 years for this land to decompose. Please help keep it out of the groundwater by avoiding it in the neighborhood nearby lakes. Don't forget to place your used hair conditioners in suitable cans. If these measures are not, please notify park staff.



**The dredging of the Black Creek Marsh** caused approximately 90% loss of shallow water habitat and water recreation trails. These channels and ponds can withstand low water periods and allow fish to spawn during low-water events.
